

Cross-Party Group Monitoring Report

November 2023

Introduction

- 1.** This paper is prepared by the Table Office for the Standards of Conduct Committee ('the Committee) in accordance with paragraph 44 of The Rules on the Operation of Cross-Party Groups ('the rules'). It provides an overview of the activities of the Senedd's Cross-Party Groups ('CPGs') between 6 October 2022 and 6 October 2023, and looks at compliance more generally since the start of the Sixth Senedd.
- 2.** Under paragraph 41 of the rules, failure to comply with, or contravention of the rules could ultimately lead to withdrawal of recognition of the group on the authority of the Llywydd (the group would be de-registered and all details removed from the Senedd's website).

Registered Cross-Party Groups

- 3.** A total of 77 CPGs have been registered since the beginning of the Sixth Senedd, with six new CPGs being registered during the current reporting period. No groups have been wound up voluntarily nor been de-registered in that time.

Compliance

- 4.** The rules on the operation of CPGs require CPG Chairs to provide the following information to the Table Office within specifies timescales:



- As much advance notice of meetings as possible (including meeting dates, times and venue);
- Notification of the election of office-holders (within four weeks of the election taking place);
- Submission of minutes (within four weeks of the meeting taking place);
- Notification of any changes to the details of the CPG (within four weeks of the changes coming into effect);
- The holding of an Annual General Meeting every twelve months, after which the Chair must provide an Annual Report and Financial Statement within six weeks of that meeting taking place.

5. A summary of each group's activities and compliance with the rules during the 2022-23 is outlined in Annex A. Compliance with the rules has been categorised as follows:

- Green: Groups who have provided all the necessary information within the required timescales.
- Yellow: Groups who have provided one set of minutes late or not at all.
- Orange: Groups who have provided more than one set of minutes late or not at all, and/or not provided an Annual Report and Financial Statement.
- Red: Groups which have not provided any of the required information on time/at all, or which appear to be inactive.

6. A list of the CPGs, along with the names of Chairs and persons/organisations providing secretarial support, is included in Annex B. Full details of all CPG meetings are available on the Senedd's website.

Compliance during Sixth Senedd

7. Last year, having reviewed the compliance report for May 2021 to October 2022, the Committee asked the Llywydd to write to all Members reminding them

of the rules on the operation of CPGs as well as their responsibilities as CPG Chairs.

8. The Llywydd also wrote specifically to the Chairs of the three apparently inactive groups, asking whether they have met or are intending to meet, or if they wish to voluntarily deregister.

9. Annex C shows all registered CPGs and, using the same categories set out in paragraph 5, shows their compliance record over the two reporting periods since the start of the Sixth Senedd. The table shows that a total of 21 CPGs have been categorised as either orange or red in both annual reports, while 18 groups are green or yellow throughout.
