**ASSEMBLY FUNCTIONS COVERED BY TRANSFER OF FUNCTIONS
ORDERS (THIRD PAPER)**

Issue

1. The Business Committee has previously asked for a paper on Assembly Functions under Acts covered by the Transfer of Functions Orders (and primarily TFO 1999) where those functions have not yet been commenced. Commencement of pre-devolution Acts has remained with UK Ministers under the TFOs.
2. I previously submitted initial papers dated 16th January 2004 and 30th January to the Business Committee. Copies of those papers are at Annex A. A final updating paper was promised for Business Committee at its meeting on 24th February 2004.
3. At Annex B is that paper with the list of the Acts in the period 1990 - 1999, functions under which have been conferred on the Assembly by TFOs. The changes since the earlier papers are highlighted for ease of reference.

ASSEMBLY FUNCTIONS COVERED BY TRANSFER OF FUNCTIONS ORDERS

Issue

The Business Committee has asked for a paper on Assembly functions under Acts covered by the Transfer of Functions Orders (and primarily TFO 1999) where those functions have not yet been commenced. Commencement of pre-devolution Acts has remained with UK Ministers.

This paper does not identify provisions in Acts, which have not yet been commenced if those provisions do not contain any Assembly functions conferred by the TFO

Annex A sets out the position for a number of Acts in the period 1990 –1998.

Further Information

It has not been possible, because of the large number of Acts involved, to cover all of the Acts covered by the various transfer of Functions Orders. It will take some additional time to check them all, however, I have initially chosen 1990 as a starting, which I think is reasonable in that increasingly with regard to pre-1990 Acts, the presumption will be that if provisions of such Acts have not yet been commenced then it is doubtful that they will ever now be commenced because policy or need for such legislation has changed. I considered that the Committee would wish to focus initially on the most recent Acts as it would be in respect of those Acts that commencement of outstanding Assembly functions may still be a live issue.

While I have concentrated on the period 1990 -1998, I have not been able to cover all Acts in that period. A number of the Acts in that period which relate to education; health; water and the environment are very large e.g. the Environment Act 1995 and the Education Act 1996 and it will take some further time to cover those Acts. I would propose to let the Committee have an updated paper covering all the Acts between 1990 and 1998 in time for its meeting on 3rd February.

In relation to the Acts covered by the paper, the paper does not address the question why any provisions have not yet been commenced.

ASSEMBLY FUNCTIONS COVERED BY TRANSFER OF FUNCTIONS ORDERS (SECOND PAPER)

Issue

1. The Business Committee has previously asked for a paper on Assembly Functions under Acts covered by the Transfer of Functions Orders (and primarily TFO 1999) where those functions have not yet been commenced. Commencement of pre-devolution Acts has remained with UK Ministers under the TFOs.
2. I submitted an initial paper dated 16th January 2004 to the Business Committee on 20th January. A copy of that paper is at Annex A. A further updating paper was promised for Business Committee at its meeting on 3rd February 2004.
3. At Annex B is an updated list of most, but still not all, Acts in the period 1990 - 1999, functions under which have been conferred on the Assembly by TFOs. The changes since the earlier paper are highlighted for ease of reference.

4. The outstanding Acts to be covered in the period 1990 -1998 are:
